

GOZO HERITAGE TRAIL

Full Day tour – Sunday 28th June 2009

Ġgantija Temples, Ta' Kola Windmill, 'The Citadel', the Old Prisons, Folklore Museum, the Archaeological Museum, and Dwejra.



We meet at Ċirkewwa at 08.30hrs to board the 09.00hrs ferry to cross over to Gozo, where an air-conditioned coach will take us to Xagħra to visit Ġgantija temples which are considered to be the oldest freestanding structures in the world and part of the UNESCO World Heritage. A Heritage Malta official will guide us round the site. We then proceed to Ta' Kola Windmill, just a short walk away. Here one can admire the folklore of a past era, which comes to life by a guide who walks us through a time gone by.

Boarding the coach once again, we drive to the Citadel, where we have a short tour of The Old Prisons, The Folklore Museum and the Archaeological museum, all within a short distance from each other.

We then leave the old medieval city to go for lunch, after which we drive to Dwejra, where one can explore the natural beauty of this area, free time to have a coffee, a cold drink or a quick dip in the little bay of Dwejra.

Departing from Dwejra at 18.30hrs to board the 19.30hrs ferry back to Malta.

Ferry tickets, transport in Gozo, admission tickets and lunch included.
